Ekeley Sciences Middle Wing Renovation Program Plan

Facilities Program Plan focuses on improving the highly deficient space on the first two levels of the center portion of Ekeley Sciences in the context of an overall plan for the future improvement and development of the facilities requirements for the Department. The space for which renovation is proposed will continue to be used for undergraduate laboratory instruction in organic and general chemistry, the two largest core instructional units in the department. Additional space on the first basement level, currently used for graduate studies, will be dedicated to advanced and honors undergraduate laboratory instruction. The space in the lower basement level will be renovated to accommodate graduate instruction in environmental and physical chemistry.
