**Food Service Renovation Facilities Study**

The University of Colorado Student Union (UCSU), the University Memorial Center UMC) conducted a financial study of its Food Service operations and submitted a report to the UCSU Executives in October 2004. After reviewing the study the UMC Food Service Study Committee concluded that a renovation of the UMC Food Service operations was imperative. The Food Service Renovation Facilities Study Plan is comprised of improvements to Food Service facilities in the University Memorial Center and three satellite operations. The last phase of the University Memeorial Center renovation concludes a revamping of the histori College Union.

The primary improvements to the seating areas in the dining rooms are to improve the ambiance, replace the furniture, create an inviting and comfortable place for dining, and to that promote a sense of community. Most other aspects of the facility are focused on retail services. This plan attempts to improve the operations, attractiveness, and create a sense of ownership and a place of destination for the students.
