E.H. French Hall Program Plan

The E. S. French Hall Program Plan update focuses on how to breathe life back into a 40 year old facility while continuing to use it for its intended purpose of providing excellence in learning, training and service. The plan addresses all of the concerns and responds with a positive, proactive and functional approach that will transform the building to meet the academic, social and cultural needs of the community for the next four decades.

The phased systematic approach identified in the program plan transforms the nearly 67, 000 gross square feet facility that includes a 500 seat theater, stage, practice facilities, classrooms, class laboratories, and offices. The renovation will also include enclosing an open courtyard located in the western half of the building and transforming it into a variety of student study and community gathering areas, this is the heart of the project.
