New Student Services Building Program Plan

The University of Northern Colorado studied the future use of the Bishop-Lehr Building to solve a variety of space needs associated with a variety of programs across campus. Multiple studies have indicated the future of the facilities is quite questionable for numerous reasons. The building has outlived its usefulness programmatically and is also deteriorating at a rapid rate from a physical perspective. This plan focused on the needs and plans for the Student Services.

The new Student Services Building consolidates all service functions and other student support functions into one facility adjacent to the University Center. The three story facilities will be a front door to the campus at 20th Street and 11th Avenue. It will be approximately 76,250 sf. The project includes the removal of Bishop-Lehr and the development of new playing fields on the site west of 11th Avenue.

JBA's role on the project was programmer, planner, project manager and project architect.
